AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

I (Name) _____ (Student ID) _____ understand and agree that by paying tuition fees to **Fanshawe College**, I have accepted Fanshawe's offer of admission and intend to study at Fanshawe in the course of study to which I have been admitted.

Location

1. The City of London is located 200 kilometres west of Toronto, Canada. I therefore understand and agree that it will be necessary for me to reside in the City of London, Ontario, Canada for the duration of my studies at Fanshawe College and that I cannot live in Toronto or any of its metropolitan suburbs (Brampton, Mississauga, Oakville) while I am a student at Fanshawe College as the distance is too great. A commutable residence is required for campuses in the cities of St.Thomas, Woodstock and Simcoe.

Refunds

2. I understand and agree that the money I pay to Fanshawe College will not be refunded except under the following circumstances:
 - (a) My application for a Study Permit (Visa) is denied by Canada. Fees paid to Fanshawe College will be refunded, minus \$250 CDN.

Or

 - (b) I accept a written offer of admission to another public college or university in Canada and apply in writing to withdraw from Fanshawe College **before the 10th day of classes** in my first semester. Fanshawe College will require a copy of the letter of admission before a refund is authorized. Fees paid to Fanshawe College will be refunded, minus \$1,000 CDN in admission, withdrawal, and administration fees. In addition students utilizing the free accommodation facilities available for upto 4 days between 26th December 2010 and 9th January 2011 will be charged \$100 CDN per day in case of a withdrawal. **NO REFUND OF FEES WILL BE APPROVED for withdrawals AFTER THE 10TH DAY OF CLASSES IN ANY SEMESTER.** Please note that all students opting for this are reported to Canadian Immigration.

Changing Course of Study

3. I understand that a place has been reserved for me in a specific program (course) of studies at Fanshawe College and therefore I am committed to continuing in that course until graduation. I may apply to change programs before the 10th day of classes in my first semester however a fee of \$250 CDN will be charged for each program transfer. Approval of a request to change programs depends on the availability of a place in the program to which I have applied and Fanshawe does not guarantee that a request to change can be approved.



English Proficiency

4. During the first month of my program, I may be required to pass a test of my academic writing ability and communication skills. If the College determines that my academic writing ability and communication skills are not sufficient to be successful in my course of studies, I may have the option of attending a preparatory semester in English for Academic Purposes. In this case, my first semester fees will pay for the course in Academic English.

Financial Resources

5. I understand that the fees I pay to Fanshawe College do not include my living expenses or the costs of required books, supplies, computer hardware/software, etc. I understand that expenses (per year) are mentioned under the General Expenses category on the second page of my Letter of Acceptance.

I Am In Canada As a Student

6. I understand that I have been admitted to Canada under a Permit to Study (Student Visa). Therefore I must continue to be a full time student to maintain my status as a student in Canada. I understand that **I will not be entitled to seek paid employment or work in Canada** until I have successfully completed at least six months of study at Fanshawe College. I will come to Canada with adequate finances to support myself.

Arrival

7. I agree to reach Fanshawe College, London, Canada, in order to participate in my program classes commencing January 4, 2011. I understand and acknowledge that the College may cancel my admission and admit another student in my place if I do not present myself at the International Office in E2025 on January 4, 2011.

I am solely responsible for, and have conducted my own research on the program, Fanshawe College, and the City of London, Ontario, Canada and having done so determined Fanshawe is the right choice for me.
