Admission Requirements for Diploma, Degree and Graduate Programs:

For certificate, diploma and degree programs we require:

- Secondary or high school transcripts with proof of graduation, subjects taken, and grades received
- English, and for most programs, Math are required at the Grade 12 level

For graduate certificate programs we require:

- College or university transcripts with proof of graduation, subjects taken, and grades received
- Resume outlining work/volunteer/internship experiences and letter of intent stating reason for applying

Note that some programs may have additional requirements. Please refer to www.georgianc.on.ca/academics/programs

For English Language proficiency, we require:

All applicants for whom English is a foreign language must provide proof of language proficiency.

Acceptable language proficiency tests include:

- Georgian College's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program with a GPA of 65 per cent or higher;
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)– internet-based test: minimum 80 (Code: 9740);
- International English Language Testing Services (IELTS)
 - Diploma/Certificate programs – IELTS with 6.0 overall and no band below 5.5
 - Degree, Graduate – IELTS with 6.5 overall and no band below 6.0
 - Bachelor of Science in Nursing with York University – IELTS with overall of 7.0 and no band below 6.0, TOEFL 89
- Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) – 800

Admission Process:

Please ensure that you include a \$100.00 CAD processing fee with your application. Applications that do not include the processing fee will not be processed. This fee does not apply to EAP/English language programs.

- 1. APPLY** - Complete and mail or courier the Georgian College International Student Application Form.
 - a. Applicants are urged to apply as early as possible to ensure that there is sufficient time to obtain a study permit.
 - b. February 1st is the equal consideration date for programs that start in September; however, applications are accepted all year round if space is available.
- 2. DOCUMENTATION** - Original or certified copies of English language test scores, academic records and any other documentation must be attached to the application.
 - a. If language testing is in progress, please forward once results are received.
 - b. Students who are not graduating until later in the year should send current transcripts along with mid-term grades.
- 3. ACCEPTANCE**
 - a. Once a decision is reached, you or your representative will receive an email with a letter of acceptance (or refusal.)
 - b. Please note that final/unconditional acceptance letters are mailed or sent by courier while conditional letters are only sent by email. A final/unconditional letter will be sent once all admission requirements are met.
 - c. Students who receive a conditional acceptance must submit the required documentation by May 1st to receive a final acceptance.
- 4. DEPOSIT** - Full tuition fees or a minimum deposit of \$750.00 CAD are due by June 1st for September start dates and October 1st for January start dates to guarantee your place in the program.
 - a. There is a \$500 administrative fee for withdrawals.
- 5. STUDY PERMIT / VISA** - Once you have an acceptance letter and tuition receipt, you may apply for a study permit / student visa from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate. Visit www.cic.gc.ca/english/study/index.asp for more information. **NOTE:** The application process could take up to 4-6 months. Please notify us: reginternational@georgianc.on.ca as soon as you receive your study permit / student visa.
- 6. HOUSING** - Complete the housing and airport pickup information included in your acceptance letter package and email or fax it to the International Centre at HomestayProgram@georgianc.on.ca or (705) 722-5158 or www.georgianc.on.ca/international
