## **Undergraduate Students**

- 2. Application Fee-non-refundable
- 3. Transcripts-Please provide all of the following that apply to you:
  - a. *Final High-School Transcripts*—An official transcript showing all work completed at the time of application is required. This report should include certified records of any national examinations required for completion of secondary education (e.g., G.C.E. "O" levels, I.B., French Baccalaureate, Bagrut, Maturita, Abitur, etc.) outside the U.S.
  - b. *College Transcripts*—Required of all applicants who are seeking admission into NYIT. Transfer work completed at another college or university must be documented via an official transcript.
