- › **Early Application Deadline: March 1, 2012**
Best course selection with advanced registration available in July.
- › **Regular Application Deadline: April 30, 2012**
Registration for courses will be available in July.
- › **Late Application Deadline:** Applications will be accepted until Friday, September 3, 2012 but students will only be admitted and allowed to register in courses as space permits.

All Other Programs

Deadlines will vary from January through August 2012. Check the Website or contact Admissions (admissions@tru.ca) to confirm deadlines for specific programs.

Transfers to TRU degrees

Students from any other college or university can apply to TRANSFER to TRU anytime after October 1. Applications will be accepted until the program is full.

Completing your application and all required documents and prerequisites as soon as possible is highly recommended.



- 2 a) BC High School Students who are applying for admission to Year 1 of a University program leading to a degree in Arts, Science, Business, Education, Social Work, Journalism, or Computing Science:**
- > If you have properly and fully completed this application, including your PEN I.D.#, and attached the \$25.50 application fee, you will not need to send any other documents. Your application will be processed, and you will be notified in writing if your application has been accepted.
- b) High School Students who are applying for admission to Year 1 of a "limited enrolment" degree (Natural Resource Science, Tourism, Forestry, Engineering, Nursing, and Fine Arts) OR Year 1 of any Diploma, Certificate or Trades program:**
- > This application is the first step in the process.
